Formatting Requirements for All Essays

These formatting requirements apply only to the final copy. However, you might want to use these settings for all of your documents.

General Settings

- 1. Font: Times New Roman 12
- 2. Margins: one inch (top, bottom, and side)
- 3. Justification: left
- 4. Spacing: double
- 5. The first line of all paragraphs should be indented with a standard tab.
- 6. Do not insert additional line spacing between paragraphs. (In the two most recent versions of Microsoft Word, you must change "space after 10 pt" to "space after 0 pt" in the "Page Layout" tab.)

Header

- 1. At the top-right $\frac{1}{2}$ margin, include a header with your last name and the page number.
 - Use the header function in your word processing program.
 - Include a single space between your last name and the number.
 - The font type and size should be Times New Roman 12.

First Page

- 1. Include the 4-line MLA heading beginning at the top-left 1" margin.
 - Student's Name
 - Instructor's Name
 - Course Name
 - Due date
- 2. Center the title of the paper.
 - The font type and size should be Times New Roman 12.
 - Do not underline, italicize, bold or otherwise format the title.
 - Do not use quotation marks around the title.
 - Do use standard capitalization.
- 3. Begin your essay directly under the title
 - Do not add additional blank spaces between the title and the first line of the introductory paragraph.
